Chapter 84

AN ACT Relating to Annual Meeting of Farmington Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 142, § 7, amended. The first paragraph of section 7 of chapter 142 of the private and special laws of 1911 is amended to read as follows:

The assessors, clerk and treasurer of said corporation shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting to be held in the month of ~~January~~ February.

Chapter 85

AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave Under Lewiston City Charter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 5, additional. Article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 5, to read as follows:

Sec. 5. Sick leave. Employees of the department of public works shall be allowed to accumulate one day of sick leave per month, a total of 12 days per year, accumulating to 120 days.

Upon retirement pursuant to the Maine State Employees Retirement System or city pension plan, an employee shall receive compensation at his rate of pay at the time of retirement for $\frac{1}{2}$ of the number of days of his unused sick leave. This clause will be retroactive to January 1, 1969.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 16-A, additional. Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 16-A, to read as follows:

Sec. 16-A. Sick leave. Members of the police department shall be allowed to accumulate one day of sick leave per month, a total of 12 days per year, accumulating to 120 days.

Upon retirement pursuant to the Maine State Employees Retirement System or city pension plan, an employee shall receive compensation at his rate of pay at the time of retirement for $\frac{1}{2}$ that number of days of his unused sick leave. This clause will be retroactive to January 1, 1969.
