Chapter 209

AN ACT Relating to Certain Classified Employees in the Forestry Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1969, c. 147, amended. Chapter 147 of the private and special laws of 1969, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

The Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 676, shall not apply to any of the above employees who, as of October 1, 1969, had satisfactorily completed at least 6 months of state service immediately previous to that date. Any employee, who had not completed 6 months of said state service prior to October 1, 1969, shall have the time served counted toward his probationary service.

Chapter 210

AN ACT to Create the Bangor Parking Authority.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the parking conditions in the City of Bangor have steadily become more intolerable and because of crowded streets, congested intersections and lack of sufficient opportunities to load and unload passengers and freight, there has arisen a condition highly dangerous to the safety and the prosperity of the citizens of said city and surrounding towns; and

Whereas, many citizens of said city have urged the immediate enactment of a bill to provide for parking meters, more parking areas and the construction of parking facilities to alleviate the above conditions; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of the State of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Bangor Parking Authority created. The people and the territory of the City of Bangor are hereby constituted as a body both politic and corporate to be known as the Bangor Parking Authority, sometimes hereinafter referred to as "authority", which shall exist and operate for the purpose of providing improved parking conditions in the City of Bangor for the betterment of the safety and prosperity of the people thereof.
