Chapter 1

RESOLVE, Designating a Certain Highway in York County as Harold L. Dow Highway.

Designation of a certain highway in York County. Resolved: That in recognition of the outstanding and unselfish service rendered to the Town of Eliot and State of Maine by Harold L. Dow, the section of State Highway 236 beginning at the Route 1 traffic circle in Kittery, proceeding through a section of the Town of Eliot and ending at the junction of Route 4 in South Berwick be named the Harold L. Dow Highway; and be it further

Resolved: That suitable signs designating said Harold L. Dow Highway be erected, subject to the approval of the State Highway Commission.

RESOLVE, Authorizing Forest Commissioner to Exchange Land in West Forks, Somerset County.

Forest Commissioner to exchange land. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be authorized to convey a parcel of land of approximately 1.3 acres on the public lot in West Forks, Somerset County, in an equal exchange of
