## Chapter 39

### **RESOLVE, Reimbursing Mars Hill Utility District for Bonds Issued for Sewer Construction.**

**Mars Hill Utility District; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$27,988 to be paid to the Mars Hill Utility District to be held and used by said district solely for the purpose of paying the principal and interest on certain Sewer Construction Serial and Term Bonds issued by said district in 1964.

Effective October 1, 1969

## Chapter 40

### **RESOLVE, to Reimburse Kermit Sanborn of South Portland for Damage by Escapees from Boys Training Center.**

**Kermit Sanborn; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$100 to be paid to Kermit Sanborn of South Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for destruction of property by 2 escapees from the Boys Training Center.

Effective October 1, 1969

## Chapter 41

**RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Copies of History of Sanford.**

**History of Sanford; purchase of. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 85 copies of the book entitled "History of Sanford", said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

Effective October 1, 1969

## Chapter 42

**RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of One Hundred Copies of History of Parkman.**

**History of Parkman; appropriation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$800 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book entitled "History of Parkman" by Roger Storms, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

Effective October 1, 1969

## Chapter 43

**RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Augusta.**

**City of Augusta, reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$28,000 to be paid to the City of Augusta as reimbursement for loss of tax revenue on the Internal Revenue Building for the years 1964, 1965 and 1966.
