Chapter 4

AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Unity College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Degrees. In addition to the rights, privileges and powers granted to Unity College by the private and special laws of 1967, chapter 102, and by the private and special laws of 1969, chapter 25, said Unity College, by appropriate action of its trustees, may confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses of study as said trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by colleges offering 2-year curricula, the degrees of Associate in Art and Associate in Applied Science.

Chapter 5

AN ACT Changing Name of Pine Tree Chapter of the Construction Specifications Institute, Inc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Change of name. The name of the Pine Tree Chapter of the Construction Specifications Institute, Inc., a corporation organized under the Maine Revised Statutes of 1964, Title 13, chapter 81, is changed to Maine Chapter of the Construction Specifications Institute, Inc.
- Sec. 2. Copy to be recorded. A copy of this Act shall be recorded in the records of the Secretary of State and the registry of deeds of Cumberland County in the same manner as certificates of incorporation are recorded.
