CHAPTER 210

AN ACT Relating to Railroad Bridge Guards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 820, amended. The first sentence of section 820 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Every railroad corporation shall erect and maintain suitable bridge guards at every bridge or other structure, any portion of which crosses the railroad less than ~~22~~ 20 feet above the tracks.

CHAPTER 211

AN ACT Including Surviving Spouse of Owner under Certain Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 151, amended. Section 151 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 12 of chapter 360 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 151. Certificate not transferable; notice of transfer

Upon the transfer of ownership, other than a transfer to the surviving spouse, of any vehicle, its registration shall expire and the person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall forthwith return the certificate of registration to the Secretary of State with a written notice containing the date of the transfer of ownership and the name, place of residence and address of the vendee and a description of the vehicle, including its motor, serial, or vehicle identification number.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 153, amended. Section 153 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 14 of chapter 360 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 153. Proration after September 1st

On any application for registration applied for by an owner or the owner's surviving spouse of a vehicle, not including a log hauler or traction engine, during the period between the first day of September and the 31st day of December, $\frac{1}{2}$ the registration fee shall be charged.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 29, § 154, amended. Section 154 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 394 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:
