CHAPTER 578**AN ACT to Increase the Salary of Court Reporters.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 651, amended. The first sentence of section 651 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 4 of chapter 590 of the public laws of 1969 and as amended by chapter 505 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended to read as follows:

The Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court may appoint not more than 15 Official Court Reporters to serve for a term of 7 years, who shall report the proceedings in the Supreme Judicial Court and in the Superior Court and who shall be officials of the court to which they may from time to time be assigned by the Chief Justice, and be sworn to the faithful discharge of their duties, and each of whom shall receive from the State a salary of ~~\$12,500~~ \$14,000 per year.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts the sum of \$43,245 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

CHAPTER 579**AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Members of the Land Use Regulation Commission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 684, amended. The 6th sentence of section 684 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 494 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Members of the commission, except state employees, shall receive \$25 per day for their services at meetings or hearings and all members shall receive necessary traveling expenses for attending any meetings of the commission or for any travel in connection with the official business of the commission and under specific authority of the commission, which traveling expenses shall be paid out of the General Fund.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Land Use Regulation Commission the sum of \$22,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1974 and the sum of \$22,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
