CHAPTER 1

AN ACT Authorizing Use of the Name Friends of Maine Medical Center.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Use of the name Friends of Maine Medical Center; authorized. The Friends of Maine Medical Center, which will be incorporated as a nonprofit, charitable corporation, is granted the authority to use the name "Friends of Maine Medical Center" as its corporate name.

Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 2

AN ACT Changing Name of Dance, Incorporated.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Change of Name. The name of Dance, Incorporated, a corporation organized under the Maine Revised Statutes of 1964, Title 13, chapter 81, is changed to Maine State Ballet.

Sec. 2. Copy recorded. A copy of this Act shall be recorded in the records of the Secretary of State.
