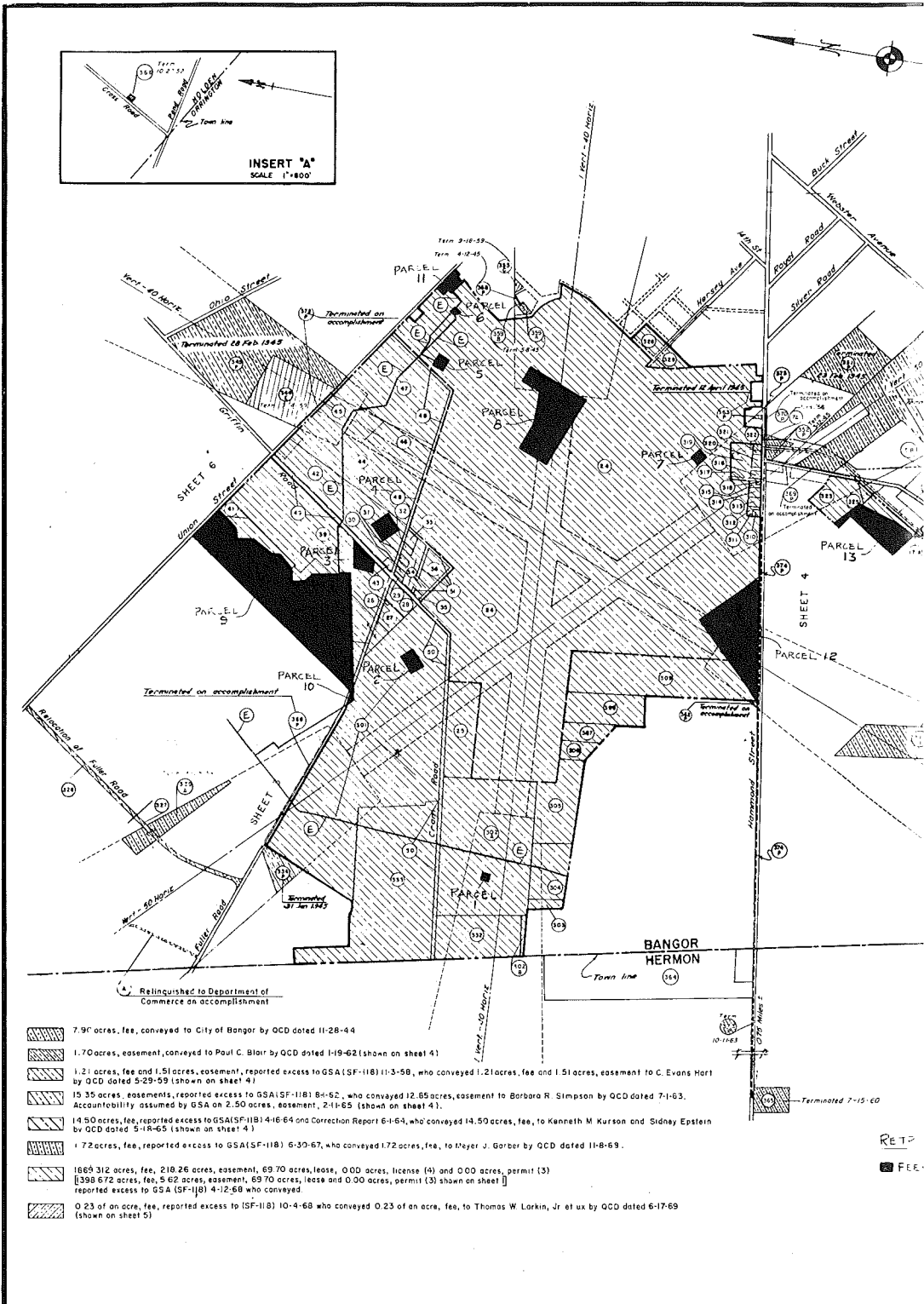

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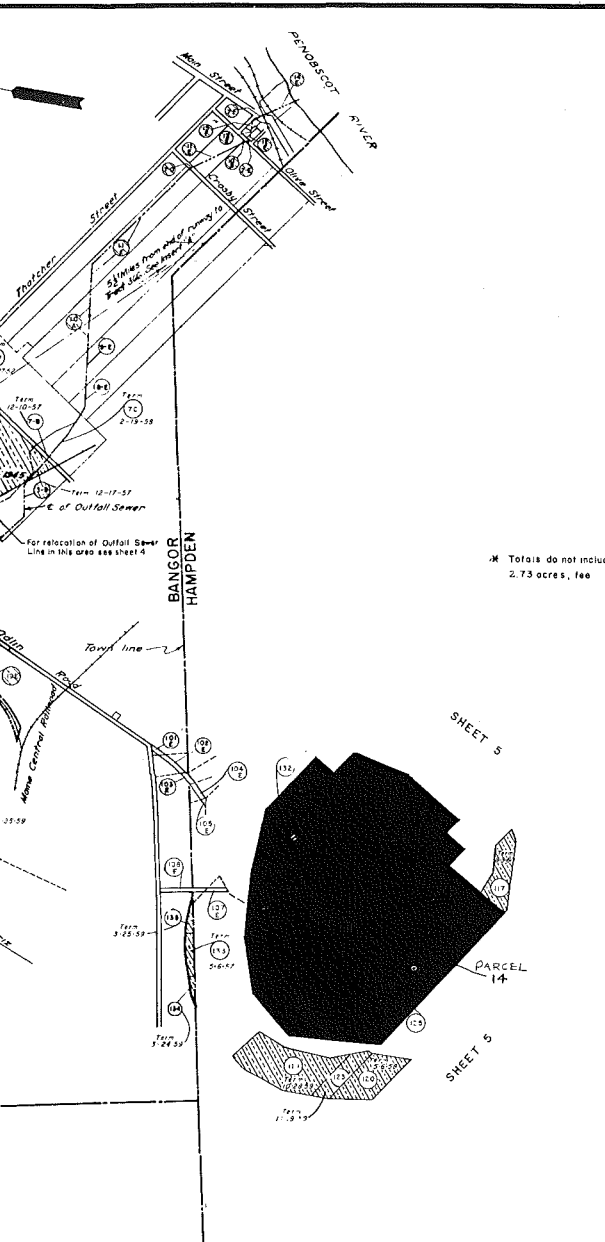

OF CONCURRENT JURISDICTION

CHAPTER 92

AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction of Certain Land at Bangor International Airport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bangor International Airport; legislative jurisdiction. The State of Maine accepts concurrent legislative jurisdiction as relinquished and ceded by the United States over certain parcels of land at the Bangor International Airport, Penobscot County, Maine, specifically identified as Parcels 1-14 on the plan entitled, "Bangor International Airport, Bangor Ammunition Storage Annex, Bangor Housing Site No. 3," dated January, 1968, appended hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

The State of Maine shall, upon the effective date of this Act, assert concurrent legislative jurisdiction over the parcels hereinabove referred to.
