CHAPTER 157

AN ACT Changing Name of Maine Tuberculosis and Health Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Change of name. The name of Maine Tuberculosis and Health Association is changed to Maine Lung Association.

Sec. 2. Copy to be recorded. A copy of this Act shall be recorded in the records of the Secretary of State in the same manner as certificates of incorporation are recorded.

CHAPTER 158

AN ACT Relating to Name of The Better Business Bureau of Maine, Inc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Better Business Bureau of Maine, Inc. The Better Business Bureau of Maine, which will be incorporated, is granted the authority to use the name "The Better Business Bureau of Maine, Inc."

CHAPTER 159

AN ACT Relating to Change of Name of The Right to Life Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Right to Life Committee; name changed. The name of Right to Life Committee is hereby authorized to use the name The Maine Right to Life Committee and to incorporate under the general laws of this State under that name.
