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CHAP. 27

In the event bids in the minimum amount as recommended are not received after the notice, the Forest Commissioner may thereafter sell for not less than the minimum amount, without asking for bids; provided that such parcel is sold on or before November 1, 1974.

The Forest Commissioner shall, upon receipt of payment as specified, record the deed in the Piscataquis Registry of Deeds at no additional charge to the purchaser, before sending the deed to the purchaser.

Abbreviations, plan and lot references are identified in the 1966 State Valuation.

#### CHAPTER 27

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections to Convey Land at the Augusta State Hospital to the Augusta Sanitary District.

Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections; authorized to convey land. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections is authorized and directed to convey to the Augusta Sanitary District by quit claim deed, for \$1 and other good and valuable consideration, all right, title and interest of the State in and to a certain parcel of land situated in Augusta in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine and comprising a part of the property of the State occupied by the Augusta State Hospital, consisting of 1.36 acres more or less, bounded and described as follows:

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the easterly side of the Kennebec River in Augusta, Maine and being on the westerly side of Hospital Street, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the westerly line of Hospital Street at the intersection of the northerly line of Kelton Road; thence northerly on the said westerly line of Hospital Street a distance of two hundred twenty-two feet (222') to a point; thence in a westerly direction at an angle of 90° and a distance of one hundred forty-three feet (143') to a point; thence in a southerly direction at an angle of 90° and a distance of seventy-three feet (73') to a point; thence in a westerly direction at an angle of 90° and a distance of one hundred eighty-nine feet (189') to a point; thence in a southerly direction at an angle of 90° and a distance of one hundred forty-four and seventy-five hundreds feet (144.75') to a point on the northerly line of the said Kelton Road; thence in an easterly direction at an angle of 90°44' along the northerly line of the said Kelton Road a distance of three hundred thirty-two feet (332') to the point of beginning and making an interior angle of 89°16'.
