Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 44

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor for Property Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,378.40 to be paid to Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation for damage to cemetery fence caused by snow plowing operations.

Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 45

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mrs. Hilma Webster of Vinalhaven for Damage to Property by Highway Construction.

Mrs. Hilma Webster; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$191.98 to be paid to Mrs. Hilma Webster for damages to her furnace due to flooding of her cellar caused by highway construction.

Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 46

RESOLVE, to Reimburse William Fitzgerald of Madison for Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.

William Fitzgerald; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,163.43 to be paid to William Fitzgerald for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route 201 in Madison.

Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 47

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Blain Crabtree of Cherryfield for Property Damage by Highway Construction.

Blain Crabtree; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$713 to be paid to Blain Crabtree of
