Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 44

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor for Property Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,378.40 to be paid to Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation for damage to cemetery fence caused by snow plowing operations.

Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 45

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mrs. Hilma Webster of Vinalhaven for Damage to Property by Highway Construction.

Mrs. Hilma Webster; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$191.98 to be paid to Mrs. Hilma Webster for damages to her furnace due to flooding of her cellar caused by highway construction.

Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 46

RESOLVE, to Reimburse William Fitzgerald of Madison for Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.

William Fitzgerald; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,163.43 to be paid to William Fitzgerald for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route 201 in Madison.

CHAPTER 47

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Blain Crabtree of Cherryfield for Property Damage by Highway Construction.

Blain Crabtree; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$713 to be paid to Blain Crabtree of Cherryfield to reimburse him for damage to his property by the construction of Highway No. 193.

Effective October 3, 1973

CHAPTER 48

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Otis Smith of Kittery for Motor Vehicle Damage Due to Highway Maintenance.

Otis Smith; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$269.58 to be paid to Otis Smith of Kittery for damage to his motor vehicle by a defective culvert as he drove over it.

CHAPTER 49

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Woodrow Bakeman of Castine for Property Damage by Highway Construction.

Woodrow Bakeman; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Woodrow Bakeman the sum of \$1,250 to reimburse him for damage to his property caused by inadequate drainage of a culvert under the highway passing in front of his house.

CHAPTER 50

RESOLVE, in Favor of South Berwick Emergency Ambulance and Rescue, Inc.

South Berwick Emergency Ambulance and Rescue, Inc.; reimbursed. Resolved: That the indebtedness in the amount of \$430 of South Berwick Emergency Ambulance and Rescue, Inc., for the sales tax due the State of Maine on an ambulance purchased on March 6, 1972 is discharged.

CHAPTER 51

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Alden V. Cole of LaGrange for Loss of Beehives by Bear.

Alden V. Cole; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$200 to be paid
