**RESOLVE**, to Reimburse Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor for Property Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation of Bangor; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,378.40 to be paid to Mount Hope Cemetery Corporation for damage to cemetery fence caused by snow plowing operations.

## CHAPTER 45

**RESOLVE**, to Reimburse Mrs. Hilma Webster of Vinalhaven for Damage to Property by Highway Construction.

Mrs. Hilma Webster; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$191.98 to be paid to Mrs. Hilma Webster for damages to her furnace due to flooding of her cellar caused by highway construction.
