**CHAPTER 76**

**RESOLVE, Relating to Granting Pipeline Easement by Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission to Town of Machias.**

Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission authorized. Resolved: That the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission is authorized and directed to grant any and all licenses, easements or deeds to the inhabitants of the Town of Machias, which said commission deems appropriate for the construction and maintenance of a sanitary sewage collection system along the approximate line as shown on plans entitled "Town of Machias, Maine, Interceptor Sewers General Location Plan" and on file in the town office of the Town of Machias.

**CHAPTER 77**

**RESOLVE, Authorizing Attorney General to Convey State's Interest in Certain Land in Bangor.**

Attorney General authorized to convey State's interest in certain land in Bangor. Resolved: That the Attorney General is hereby authorized to execute a deed to George F. Burns and Kathleen G. Burns both of Bangor, County of Penobscot, State of Maine, conveying all the right, title and interest of the State of Maine in and to the following property:
