PUBLIC LAWS, 1975

Certificates shall be renewed on or before July 1st each year by paying a renewal fee of \$15 \$30 for each renewal biennially.

Effective October 1, 1975

CHAPTER 120

AN ACT Relating to Payments to the County Law Libraries in the Several Counties of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

27 MRSA § 224, 2nd to 17th [[], as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 540, § 4, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Androscoggin, \$9,500;

Aroostook, \$5,600 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Houlton and \$3,000 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library in the court house at Caribou in said county;

Cumberland, \$10,000 which shall be paid to the treasurer of the Cumberland Bar Association for the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law Library;

Franklin, \$5,000;

Hancock, \$7,000;

Kennebec, \$6,000;

Knox, \$3,500;

Lincoln, \$4,500;

Oxford, \$3,000 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at South Paris and \$3,500 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at Rumford;

Penobscot, \$3,000;

Piscataquis, \$3,500;

Sagadahoc, \$4,250;

Somerset, \$6,500;

Waldo, \$3,500;

Washington, \$3,800;

York, \$5,000.
