CHAPTER 43

RESOLVE, Authorizing and Directing the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to Permit Great Northern Paper Company to Cut and Remove Wood from Township 6, Range 11, W.E.L.S.

The Director of the Bureau of Public Lands; authorized. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands is hereby authorized and directed to issue a stumpage permit to Great Northern Paper Company (a division of Great Northern Nekoosa Corporation) allowing said company to cut and remove 100,000 cords of fir wood of all sizes and spruce wood in excess of 12½" d.b.h. from Township 6, Range 11, W.E.L.S., said company paying therefor \$8 per cord as stumpage for 25,000 cords, the remaining 75,000 cords to be removed free of any stumpage cost to said company.

Said permit shall expire on May 1, 1979.
