CHAPTER 81

AN ACT Providing for a Fishway at the Frankfort Dam in Frankfort.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Fishway. A fishway shall be erected under the supervision of the Department of Marine Resources at the outlet dam on the Frankfort Dam in Frankfort.

CHAPTER 82

AN ACT to Provide Road and Bathing Facilities at Birches Point Park at Owls Head.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Road and bathing facilities at Birches Point Park authorized. The Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation, shall construct and maintain a road and bathing facilities at Birches Point Park at Owls Head.

CHAPTER 83

AN ACT Concerning the Referendum Date for AN ACT to Annex the Town of Otisfield to Oxford County.

PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1977

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P&SL 1977, c. 10, Referendum, 7th ¶, 1st sentence, is amended to read:

If this Act is deemed approved by the Town of Otisfield, it shall be submitted to the legal voters of Oxford County at a special election to be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November, 1977 same day as the special election to be held in accordance with the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 18 on 108th Legislature Initiated Bill #1: "AN ACT to Repeal the State Property Tax."
