CHAPTER 37

H. P. 57 — L. D. 66

AN ACT to Change the Date on Which the Annual Sessions of the County Commissioners are Held.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 151, as amended by PL 1969, c. 99, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§ 151. Sessions; times; places

The county commissioners shall hold sessions in the shire town of each county at least 3 times annually in 3 different months and at other times or other places which they may designate.

CHAPTER 38

H. P. 315 — L. D. 421

AN ACT Relating to the Wholesale Sale of Malt Liquor and Wine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 654 is enacted to read:

§ 654. Reports of domestic manufacturers and foreign wholesalers

All breweries, wineries, vintners, brokers, importers and out-of-state wholesalers shall obtain a certificate of approval from the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages. Licensed Maine wholesalers appointed by them as exclusive distributors for specific brands of alcoholic beverages cannot be terminated as
