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**PUBLIC LAWS**  
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**CHAPTER 611**  
**H. P. 1737 — L. D. 1855**

**AN ACT Providing for the Election of a Deputy Moderator at Town Meetings.**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:**

30 MRSA § 2054, sub-§ 3, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 536, §§ 7 and 8, is further amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read:

**If the moderator is absent or is unable to carry out his duties, the clerk, or in his absence a selectman or constable, may call for the election of a deputy moderator to act in the absence of the moderator.**

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**CHAPTER 612**  
**H. P. 1750 — L. D. 1866**

**AN ACT Relating to Interest on Supplemental Assessments under the Tax Laws.**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:**

36 MRSA § 713, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1973, c. 695, § 15, is further amended by adding at the end 2 new sentences to read:

**Interest shall accrue on all unpaid balances of any supplemental tax, beginning on the 60th day after the date of commitment of the supplemental tax to the collector or the date interest accrues for delinquent taxes under the original commitment, whichever occurs later. The rate of interest shall be the same as specified by the municipality for the current tax year, in accordance with section 505, subsection 4.**

**H. P. 1736 — L. D. 1854**

**AN ACT Pertaining to the Time for Recording a Tax Lien Mortgage.**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:**
