promulgate rules requiring annual certification and calibration of this equipment by competent technicians.

Sec. 3. 10 MRSA § 105 is enacted to read:

§ 105. Registration fees

The annual fee for registrations issued for operating nuclear power reactors is \$59,200 per unit.

Sec. 4. Permanent fund. All fees shall be paid to the Treasurer of State to be maintained as a permanent fund and used by the Department of Human Services for carrying out the provisions of this Act.

CHAPTER 685

S. P. 737 — L. D. 1916

AN ACT Relating to Requirements for School Bus Operators and to the Inspection of School Buses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 2013, sub-§ 1, ¶ F is enacted to read:

F. Shall not be a habitual offender, as defined in section 2292.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 2017, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 29, is amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read:

In addition, twice during the school year, between September 1st and November 30th and between March 1st and May 31st at a time and place convenient to the appropriate school authorities or an owner, each school bus, as defined in this Title, shall be submitted to an inspection conducted by the State Police.
