CHAPTER 57

S. P. 194 — L. D. 461

AN ACT Providing Funds for Young Women’s Christian Association Fair Harbor Shelter in Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Young Women’s Christian Association Fair Harbor Shelter in Portland. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
