H. P. 1680 — L. D. 1789

### AN ACT to Expand the State's Tourism Promotion Effort.

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:**

## CHAPTER 102

H. P. 1754 — L. D. 1881

**AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for an Increase in Board Rates for Foster Parents and Clothing Allowances for Children under the Care or Custody of the Department of Human Services.**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:**
