6 MRSA § 53, sub-§ 5, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 678, § 32, is amended to read:

Nothing in this section shall permit aircraft dealers brokers from using aircraft offered for sale for more than 15 months from the date that the aircraft is first offered for sale.

CHAPTER 81

H. P. 103 — L. D. 137

AN ACT Relating to the Raising of Wild Waterfowl in Captivity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7235, sub-§ 5. ¶D is enacted to read:

D. Notwithstanding subsection 4, metallic seals are not required for wild waterfowl marked in accordance with applicable federal regulations.

CHAPTER 82

H. P. 387 — L. D. 430

AN ACT to Clarify Lobbyist Disclosure Procedures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA \S 314, first \P , as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 632, \S 1, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Joint registrations filed in December of an even-numbered year shall automatically expire on the last day of the following calendar year.

Sec. 2. 3 MRSA § 320, 2nd ¶, first sentence, as reenacted by PL 1975, c. 724, is amended to read:

The Secretary of State shall, no later than December 15th of each the year prior
