CHAPTER 112

H. P. 4 — L. D. 4

AN ACT Relating to Pesticide Registration.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA § 1471-B, sub-§ 6, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 644, § 3, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA § 1471-O is enacted to read:

§ 1471-O. Exercise of powers by Board of Pesticides Control

The powers established under the Maine Pesticide Control Act of 1975, Title 7, chapter 103, subchapter II-A, shall be exercised by the Board of Pesticides Control established by section 1471-B.

CHAPTER 113

H. P. 285 — L. D. 332

AN ACT to Revise the Law Relating to the Licensing of Private Security Guards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA c. 54, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 508, § 1, is repealed.

CHAPTER 93

PRIVATE SECURITY GUARDS

§ 9401. Short title

This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Private Security Guards Act."

§ 9402. Purpose

It is the purpose of this chapter to regulate any person engaging in the business of providing a private security guard or private security guards.
