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## CHAPTER 124

H. P. 896 — L. D. 1063

**AN ACT to Provide for an Annual Report by the Board of Trustees of the Maine State Retirement System to the Legislature.**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:**

5 MRSA § 1007 is enacted to read:

### **§ 1007. Report to the Legislature**

The board of trustees shall make a written report to the appropriate legislative committee on or before the 15th of January each year. That report shall contain a discussion of any areas of policy or administration which, in the opinion of the board, should be brought to the attention of the committee and any proposed legislation amending the retirement system law which the board recommends to improve the system.

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## CHAPTER 125

H. P. 356 — L. D. 404

**AN ACT to Provide for Direct Payment to Municipalities of Fines Collected under Certain Laws Relating to Animals.**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:**

7 MRSA § 3705, 2nd sentence, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 541, Pt.A, § 77, is further amended to read:

All fines and forfeitures imposed shall be paid into the treasury of the county where the offense is committed and shall be transmitted by the county treasurer to the treasurer of the municipality where the offense or violation is committed unless otherwise provided.
