CHAPTER 460
H. P. 164 — L. D. 190

AN ACT to Increase Registration Fees under the Maine Consumer Credit Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

9-A MRSA § 6-203, sub-§ 1, as amended by PL 1975, c. 179, § 3, is further amended to read:

1. A person required to file notification shall at the time he files such notification pay to the administrator an annual fee of ~~\$10~~ **\$20** for that year and an annual fee of ~~\$5~~ **\$10** for each branch thereof.

CHAPTER 461
H. P. 218 — L. D. 255

AN ACT to Provide a Special Muzzle-loading Hunting Season.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 7001, sub-§ 23-A is enacted to read:

23-A. Muzzle-loading firearm. "Muzzle-loading firearm" means a rifle that is:

- A. Forty caliber or greater;**
- B. Capable of firing only a single charge;**
- C. Equipped with a barrel 20 inches or more in length;**
- D. Loaded through the muzzle with powder and a ball or bullet; and**
- E. Ignited by a percussion cap or priming charge of a flint, match or wheel lock mechanism.**

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA § 7107 is enacted to read:
