CHAPTER 586

H.P. 1735 - L.D. 1720

AN ACT to Clarify Certain Provisions of the Public Advocates Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- 35 MRSA §1-A, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 479, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 3. Service. The professional employees of the Public Advocate shall serve during the pleasure of the Public Advocate; all other employees of the Public Advocate shall be subject to the Personnel Law.

Effective July 13, 1982.

CHAPTER 587

H.P. 1819 - L.D. 1804

AN ACT Related to Handicapped Parking in Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30 MRSA §2151, sub-§2, ¶K is enacted to read:

K. Providing for the establishment and policing of parking spaces designated for handicapped persons. A municipality with off-street public parking areas may set aside an adequate number of these spaces for use by handicapped persons. A municipality with on-street public parking spaces may set aside an adequate number of these spaces in appropriate locations for use by handicapped persons. There shall be adjacent to and visible from each handicapped parking space a posted
