S. P. 201 — L. D. 568

AN ACT to Provide Funds for the Provision of the State Cost Sharing of Telecommunication Typewriters for the Hearing Impaired.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
