CHAPTER 6

H. P. 481 — L. D. 528

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State to Convey Certain Land to the Town of Swan's Island for Park and Recreational Purposes.

Director of Parks and Recreation; authorized. Resolved: That the Director of Parks and Recreation is authorized to convey to the Town of Swan's Island, for public park and recreational purposes, approximately 2½ acres of land with buildings on Swan's Island as acquired by deed from Marjorie Setman dated August 30, 1971, and recorded at the Hancock County Registry of Deeds in Book 1125, page 511. The conveyance given by the State through the Director of Parks and Recreation shall contain a covenant that shall require that the parcel shall be used only for the purposes for which it was conveyed and shall not be conveyed by the town, and shall revert to the State if used for any other purpose or if conveyed.

CHAPTER 7

H. P. 1030 — L. D. 1195

RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Waldo County for the Year 1981.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Waldo County has certain expenses and liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1981 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed, in order to provide the required revenue for the county; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it
