RESOLVE, Adjusting the Authorized
Expenditures of Cumberland County
for the Year 1982.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, a clerical error was made in Resolve 1981, chapter 60, "Resolve, for the Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Cumberland County for the Year 1982," by placing certain funds in the wrong account; and

Whereas, the county commissioners are without authority to correct the error; and

Whereas, unless corrected immediately, the Cumberland County sheriff's department will be without funds necessary to remain in operation; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Certain authorized General Fund expenditures adjusted.
Resolved: That the following sums, authorized by Resolve 1981, chapter 60, section 2, are amended to read:
