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## CHAPTER 323

H.P. 1175 - L.D. 1563

AN ACT Pertaining to Directions from  
Interstate 95 to the Maritime Provinces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

23 MRSA §1201, sub-§16-A, as enacted by PL 1967, c. 440, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

16-A. Maritime Provinces. This sign shall be constructed and maintained on Interstate 95 near the northbound Howland exit and shall be worded as follows:

MARITIME PROVINCES

NEXT EXIT

NORTHERN MARITIME PROVINCES

EXIT 63

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## CHAPTER 324

H.P. 866 - L.D. 1114

AN ACT to Clarify the Rights of Putative  
Fathers in Adoption Proceedings.
