## CHAPTER 612

H.P. 1447 - L.D. 1899

AN ACT to Permit School Administrative Units to Acquire Certain Small Parcels of Land without Following the School Construction Project Approval Process.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §15901, sub-§4, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

C. The cost of land acquisition acquired in conjunction with projects otherwise defined by this subsection;

Effective July 25, 1984.

## CHAPTER 613

H.P. 1462 - L.D. 1914

AN ACT to Clarify the Definition of School Construction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §15901, sub-§4, ¶E, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

E. The complete restoration of existing school buildings in lieu of replacement when in the judgment of the commissioner the action is in the best interest of the State and local unit; and

Effective July 25, 1984.
