CHAPTER 11

H.P. 345 - L.D. 404

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Hallowell Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1971, c. 83, §10 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Any person who shall place, discharge or leave any offensive or injurious matter or material on or in the conduits, catch basins or receptacles of the district contrary to its regulations, or shall knowingly injure any conduit, pipe, reservoir, flush tank, catch basin, manhole, outlet, engine, pump or other property held, owned or used by the district shall be liable to pay twice the amount of the damage to the district, to be recovered in any proper action; and that person is guilty of a Class E crime.

Effective September 23, 1983.

CHAPTER 12

H.P. 346 - L.D. 405

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Winthrop Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1923, c. 98, §16 is amended to read:

Sec. 16. Incidental powers granted. All incidental powers, rights and privileges necessary to the accomplishment of the main object ~~herein~~ set forth in this section are granted to the public municipal corporation ~~hereby~~ created in this section. Any person who places, discharges or leaves any offensive or injurious matter or material on or in the sewer conduits, catch basins or sewer receptacles of the district contrary to its sewer use regulations, or knowingly injures any sewer conduit, pipe, reservoir, flush tank, catch basin, manhole, outlet, engine, pump or other property held, owned or used by the
