be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the following schedule. Allocation from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund, income previously allocated from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund, (\$38,335), in excess of 7%, but not expended, is reallocated for the fiscal year July 1, 1983, to June 30, 1984, and shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in this Act. The allocation shown for fiscal year 1983-84 combines \$160,000 newly allocated and \$38,335 reallocated.

Sec. 2. Allocation from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund. Income not otherwise allocated from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund (\$160,000) is allocated for the fiscal year July 1, 1984, to June 30, 1985, and shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the following schedule:

CHAPTER 39

H.P. 1258 - L.D. 1679

AN ACT to Increase Funding Allocation
for the Bureau of Air Quality Control for
Fiscal Year 1983.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, insufficient funding is currently allocated to continue the functions assigned to the Bureau of Air Quality Control through the remainder of fiscal year 1983; and

Whereas, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has increased its grant to the department under the United States Public Law 95-95, Section 105, as amended, in order to enable the Bureau of Air Quality Control to carry out its responsibilities; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Allocation. In addition to allocations made previously under the Air Pollution Control Program Grant, the following funds are allocated:
