**CHAPTER 88**

S.P. 864 - L.D. 2343

AN ACT Making Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1984 and 1985.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, the Office of Energy Resources has received a federal grant to undertake a biomass conversion project of state facilities; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Federal Expenditure Fund for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1984 and 1985, to the Office of Energy Resources:
