CHAPTER 103

S.P. 692 - L.D. 1924

AN ACT to Appropriate to the Maine
State Commission on the Arts and the
Humanities Fund for the Management of the
Percent for Art Act.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, an Act to provide works of art in public places and other facilities, commonly known as the Percent for Art Act, has generated more projects than initially expected; and

Whereas, more artists have expressed interest in the Percent for Art Program than originally anticipated; and

Whereas, additional funds are necessary in the next fiscal year for the management of the Percent for Art Act; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for a part-time position, maintenance of the artists' slide registry, travel expenditures of agency staff and advisory selection committees, printing and mailing costs and visual and written documentation.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

CHAPTER 104

S.P. 703 - L.D. 1941

AN ACT to Appropriate Funds to the Maine State Commission on the Arts and the Humanities for the Maine Touring Artists Program.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Maine Touring Artists Program provides assistance to local not-for-profit community sponsoring agencies which bring professional artists to their communities for performances, workshops, demonstrations and residencies; and

Whereas, requests for the next fiscal year are expected to be more than double the amount currently budgeted for the program; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following
