## CHAPTER 106

H.P. 1825 - L.D. 2420

### AN ACT to Appropriate Funds to the University of Maine to Implement Collective Bargaining Agreements.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to tentative collective bargaining agreements reached between the University of Maine and its employees will become due and payable immediately; and

Whereas, funding must be provided immediately if those obligations and expenses are to be met; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

UNIVERSITY OF MAINE1984-85

All Other

\$6,232,709

These funds are to be used to fund collective bargaining agreements reached between the University of Maine and its employees contingent upon the receipt of state funding and to provide equivalent increases to nonrepresented and confidential employees.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

Effective May 7, 1984.
