CHAPTER 1

H.P. 501 - L.D. 567

RESOLVE, Providing for the Expenditure of
Public Service Tax Receipts Credited to
Edmunds Township.

Expenditure of funds by Washington County Commissioners for Edmunds Township. Resolved: That public service tax revenues, not to exceed \$8,000, attributable to public service taxes assessed in Edmunds Township prior to the enactment of Public Law 1979, chapter 666, may be spent by the county commissioners of Washington County for improvements to the Dennys River Recreation Center located in Edmunds Township.

CHAPTER 2

S.P. 171 - L.D. 526

RESOLVE, to Name the Brook and Pond Located
on the West Poland Road in Oxford County and
on the West Shore of Thompson Lake
in Honor of the Perkins Family.

Perkins Brook and Pond; Oxford County named. Resolved: That the brook running from a small pond on the east shore of Thompson Lake off the West Poland Road be named Perkins Brook; and be it further

Resolved: That the pond which is the head waters of Perkins Brook, so called, be named Perkins Pond.

CHAPTER 3

S.P. 162 - L.D. 450

RESOLVE, to Authorize the Commissioners
of Cumberland County to Reimburse the Town
of Standish \$4,620.21 Unexpended
Retirement Funds.

Cumberland County Commissioners; reimbursement to Town of Standish. Resolved: That the County Commissioners of Cumberland County are authorized to reimburse the Town of Standish \$4,620.21 for unexpended charges resulting from a withdrawal from participation in the Maine State Retirement System.

CHAPTER 4

H.P. 526 - L.D. 651

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Director of Parks and Recreation to Convey by Deed the Interest of the State of Maine in 3 Certain Parcels of Real Property.

Director of the Bureau of Parks and Recreation; property conveyed by quitclaim deed. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Recreation may convey by quitclaim deed and for no monetary consideration the following properties:

1. To the inhabitants of the Town of Rockport, a parcel containing 3.7+ acres known as Rockport Marine Park, as acquired from George Stevenson, et al, by deed, dated August 28, 1970, and recorded at the Knox County Registry of Deeds in Book 511, page 424;

2. To the inhabitants of the Town of Bristol, certain real property containing 5.3+ acres known as the Pemaquid River Boat Facility Property, as acquired from Carl M. Hanna and Katherine B. Hanna, by deed, dated December 30, 1970, and recorded at the Lincoln County Registry of Deeds in Book 683, page 189; and

3. To the inhabitants of the Town of Mt. Desert, certain real property containing 2.66+ acres known as the Long Pond Boat Access Site, as acquired from Luzetta S. Smith, et al, by deed, dated January 18, 1971, and recorded at the Hancock County Registry of Deeds in Book 1111, page 595.

Each shall be on such terms and conditions and for such consideration, as the director may direct.
