Whereas, it is unclear as to what will happen to these funds without specific legislation addressing the situation; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Androscoggin County; allocation. Resolved: That funds allocated for food stamps in the Androscoggin County budget for the year 1983 shall not be expended for that purpose, or any other purpose, but shall lapse to unencumbered surplus to be used entirely for reducing the tax levy in the ensuing year.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Effective June 7, 1983.

CHAPTER 39

S.P. 580 - L.D. 1676

RESOLVE, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities
on Account of Taxes Lost Due to Lands being
Classified under the Tree Growth Tax Law.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, certain municipalities have been reimbursed 75% of the tax loss pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 578, and there remains moneys due these municipalities; and

Whereas, certain municipalities currently need the remaining reimbursement funds due to the taxes lost; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Reimbursements to be paid to certain municipalities. Resolved: That the following designated municipalities be reimbursed for the sums indicated totaling \$224,710.74 under the provisions of the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 578, subsection 1:

CHAPTER 40

H.P. 1277 - L.D. 1693

RESOLVE, Authorizing and Directing the
Maine State Commission on the Arts and the
Humanities to Prepare and Make Available
to Artists a Form Contract for the
Protection of Works of Art.

Maine State Commission on the Arts and the Humanities is authorized and directed to prepare and make available certain form contracts. Resolved: That the Maine State Commission on the Arts and the Humanities is authorized and directed to:

1. Prepare a form contract that an artist and heirs of the artist may use and have executed by the owners of works of art by the artist. The contract shall provide for agreement by the owner not to physically deface, mutilate or destroy the work of art without permission of the artist or the heir of the artist;
2. Make the form contract available upon request to any interested Maine artist, governmental entity or other interested persons; and
3. Distribute the form contract to any artist or
