Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6022, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is amended to read:

6. Enforcement agreements. The commissioner may enter into reciprocal enforcement agreements with political subdivisions of the State and with other states, regional authorities and the Federal Government. Pursuant to these agreements, the commissioner may designate and deputize federal law enforcement personnel and law enforcement personnel from other states to enforce marine resource laws and rules. In that event, the commissioner shall designate the specific laws and rules to be enforced. Agents so deputized may enforce those laws and rules so designated by the commissioner. Agents so deputized by the commissioner shall have the powers of a marine patrol officer, as defined in section 6025.

CHAPTER 25

H.P. 169 - L.D. 203

AN ACT to Allow Transmittal of Certificates of Illegitimate Births to Other Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 MRSA §2702, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1967, c. 186, §2, is further amended to read:

3. Transmittal of certificates to other municipalities. When the parents of any child born are residents of any other municipality in this State, or when any deceased person was a resident of any other municipality in this State, the clerk of the municipality where ~~such~~ that live birth or death occurred shall, between the 10th and the 15th of the month next following, transmit a certified copy of the certificate of ~~such~~ the live birth or death to the clerk of the municipality where ~~such~~ the parents reside, or where the deceased was a resident, ~~except that in the case of an illegitimate birth no such certified copy shall be sent.~~
