Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30 MRSA §2061, sub-§5, ¶G, as amended by PL 1981, c. 86, §1, is further amended to read:

G. A sufficient number of ballots shall be printed, photocopied or otherwise mechanically reproduced and furnished, and a record of the number shall be kept by the clerk. The printed ballots shall be packaged in convenient blocks so that they may be removed separately.

CHAPTER 31

H.P. 201 - L.D. 235

AN ACT to Designate the 3rd Week in October
as Maine Business Women's Week.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §124 is enacted to read:

§124. Maine Business Women's Week

The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside the 3rd full week in October as Maine Business Women's Week. The proclamation shall invite and urge the people of the State to observe the week in schools and other suitable places with appropriate ceremony and study. The Department of Educational and Cultural Services and the Maine Commission for Women may make appropriate information available to the people and the schools within the limits of their budgets.

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §4805, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

7. Maine Business Women's Week. Maine Business Women's Week is the 3rd full week in October in accordance with Title 1, section 124.
