- A. Any person specified by the statute authorizing the rulemaking;
- B. Any person who has filed within the past year a written request with the agency for notice of rulemaking; and
- C. Any trade, industry, professional, interest group or regional publication that the agency deems effective in reaching the persons affected; and.
- D. The Secretary of State, for publication in accordance with subsection 5.

Notification to subscribers under paragraph B shall be by mail or otherwise in writing to the last address provided to the agency by that person. Subscribers under paragraph B may request to receive a copy of each proposed rule with the written notice. The agency shall provide the copy at the same time the notice is sent.

Written notice shall also be given to the Secretary of State, by the deadline established by him, for publication in accordance with subsection 5.

Sec. 3. 5 MRSA §8056, sub-§1, ¶B, as amended by PL 1981, c. 524, §11, is further amended to read:

B. File a certified copy of the rule and the statement required by section 8052, subsection 5, with the Secretary of State in a form prescribed by the Secretary of State, which form shall be susceptible to frequent and easy revision;

CHAPTER 40

S.P. 86 - L.D. 267

AN ACT Relating to Radiation User Fees Under the Human Services Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §680, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 345, §§13 and 14, is amended to read:

1. Nuclear power plants. The annual registration fee for operating nuclear power plants is ~~\$59,200~~ \$75,000 per year.

Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from other special revenues for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1986, and June 30, 1987, to carry out the purposes of this Act.

CHAPTER 41

H.P. 676 - L.D. 936

AN ACT to Establish Alcohol Awareness Week.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §123 is enacted to read:

§123. Alcohol awareness week

The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside the first full week in December of each year as Alcohol Awareness Week. The proclamation shall invite and urge citizens, alcoholism service agencies, schools and other suitable organizations and groups to observe this week through appropriate activities. The Alcohol and Drug Abuse Planning Committee shall, through the departments represented on the committee, make appropriate information available to citizens, organizations and groups within the limits of their budgets.

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §4803, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
