2. Posting signs. There shall be posted in conspicuous places, a sufficient number of signs prohibiting smoking. The letters in the sign shall be at least 1 1/2 inches high and proportionately wide.

§1684. Civil violation

Failure of an individual to comply with section 1683 is a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not more than \$50 may be adjudged.

## CHAPTER 116

H.P. 611 - L.D. 881

AN ACT to Adjust the Boundaries between House District 103 and House District 55.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 MRSA §1571-B, sub-§5, House Districts 55 and 103, as amended by PL 1983, c. 862, §68, are further amended to read:

District Number 55, consisting of the municipalities of Carrabassett Valley, Coplin Plantation, Dallas Plantation, Eustis, Industry, Kingfield, Madrid, New Vineyard, Phillips and Strong, and the unorganized territories of East Franklin County, North Franklin County, and Wyman Township, in Franklin County, the municipalities of Embden, Highland Plantation and New Portland, and the unorganized ~~territories~~ territory of Central Somerset County, known as Lexington and ~~Geneer~~ Townships Township in Somerset County.

District Number 103, consisting of the municipalities of Anson, Athens, Bingham, Brighton Plantation, Caratunk, Dennistown Plantation, Highland Plantation, Jackman, Moose River, Moscow, Pleasant Ridge Plantation, Solon, The Forks Plantation, West Forks Plantation and the unorganized territories of East Somerset County, North Somerset County and West Somerset County, and the unorganized territory of Central Somerset

County, known as Concord Township in the County of Somerset.

## CHAPTER 117

H.P. 769 - L.D. 1061

AN ACT to Establish Eligibility for Burial in  
the Maine Veterans' Memorial Cemetery  
for Members of the Maine National  
Guard.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §504, sub-§4, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 460, §3, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §504, sub-§4, ¶A-1 is enacted to read:

A-1. As used in this subsection, unless the context indicates otherwise, the following terms have the following meanings.

(1) "Eligible dependent" means the wife, husband, surviving spouse, unmarried minor child or unmarried adult child who became incapable of self-support before reaching 18 years of age on account of mental or physical defects.

(2) "Eligible veteran" means any person who:

(a) Served on active duty in the United States Armed Forces during any federally recognized period of conflict or was eligible for an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal or campaign medal, and who:

(i) If discharged, received an honorable discharge or a general discharge under honorable conditions, provided that the discharge
