### CHAPTER 144

H.P. 950 - L.D. 1348

AN ACT Concerning Hunting with Bow and Arrow on Privately Owned Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA  $\S7102$ , sub- $\S5$ ,  $\PK$ , as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 543,  $\S9$ , is repealed.

Effective September 19, 1985.

### CHAPTER 145

H.P. 573 - L.D. 844

AN ACT to Increase the Penalties for Stocking Fish in Inland Waters without a Permit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- 12 MRSA §7901, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
- 8. Violation of section 7371, subsection 3. A violation of section 7371, subsection 3 as it applies to section 7203, subsection 1, in addition to being a Class E crime is a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$10,000 may be adjudged.

Effective September 19, 1985.
