CHAPTER 261

H.P. 366 - L.D. 486

AN ACT to Allow Sheriffs' Deputies to Hold Nonpartisan Local Office.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30 MRSA §951, last ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 394, §4, is amended to read:

A full-time deputy shall not hold the municipal office of selectman, city councilman or budget committeeman or any other municipal, county or state office, and may reside outside the county during the term of his appointment only with the permission of the sheriff and county commissioners.

CHAPTER 262

S.P. 320 - L.D. 809

AN ACT Concerning Misuse of Dealer Plates and Clarification of Dealer Plate Provisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §350-A, sub-§1, ¶¶J and K, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 694, §497, are amended to read:

J. Failure to appear at a hearing required by the Secretary of State; ~~or~~

K. Failure to comply or to maintain compliance with section 832: ; ~~or~~
