F. The guardian ad litem may request the court to appoint legal counsel for him. The District Court shall pay reasonable costs and expenses of his legal counsel.

CHAPTER 582

H.P. 1363 - L.D. 1917

AN ACT to Remove Barriers to the Appropriate Disclosure of Mental Health Information.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

34-B MRSA §1207, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 459, §7, is amended to read:

A. A client, his legal guardian, if any, or, if he is a minor, his parent or legal guardian may give his informed written consent to the disclosure of information; if he has been given the opportunity to review the information sought to be disclosed;

CHAPTER 583

H.P. 1366 - L.D. 1930

AN ACT to Clarify the Education Funding Laws Relating to Reduction of State Aid to School Districts Based on the Receipt of Certain Federal Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §15612, sub-§ 5, ¶¶B and C, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. G, §§2 and 4, are amended to read:

B. The state share of the foundation allocation to that school administrative unit shall be adjusted by subtracting the receipts under the United States laws of September 30, 1950, Chapter 1124, United States Code, Section 236, et seq., Public Law 81-874, Section 3 (c) (1), in the same proportion that total local revenues under the state equalization program are to total local revenues for education in that unit.

C. The amount subtracted under paragraph B may not exceed 90% of the school administrative unit's Section 3 (c) (1) payment of entitlement for the year prior to the year of allocation or the base year of allocation, whichever is less. In adjusting the allocation, the amounts subtracted for pupils residing on land under control of the Federal Government or a federal agency, or on a federal military reservation shall not exceed $1/2$ of the national average expenditure per pupil, as computed by the Federal Government, multiplied by the number of students in the school administrative unit.

CHAPTER 584

H.P. 1502 - L.D. 2117

AN ACT to Strengthen Provisions Relating to
the Delivery of the Publications of
State Agencies to the Maine State
Library for Reliable Public Access.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1 MRSA §501-A, as amended by PL 1975, c. 746, §1, is further amended to read:

§501-A. Publications of state agencies

The publications of all agencies and the University of Maine and the Maine Maritime Academy may be printed, bound and distributed, subject to Title 5, sections 43 ~~through~~ to 46. The State Purchasing Agent may determine the style in which such publications may be printed and bound, with the approval of the Governor. At least 55 copies of any annual or biennial report not included in the Maine State Government
