CHAPTER 68

H.P. 152 - L.D. 186

AN ACT to Establish a Fire Fighter Training Facilities Grant Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Grant funds shall be awarded each year by the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services on recommendations of the training facilities subcommittee of the Commissioner's Advisory Committee for Fire Service Training in accordance with department rules pertaining to grant awards. The commissioner shall establish eligibility criteria based on statewide need, impact of each proposed project and past grant awards. At least 4 grant awards

shall be made each year, one in each of the following regions, provided that grant applications are received from those regions: Region #1: Aroostook County, Penobscot County, Washington County, Hancock County; Region #2: Piscataquis County, Somerset County, Waldo County, Knox County; Region #3: Franklin County, Kennebec County, Lincoln County, Sagadahoc County; and Region #4: Oxford County, Androscoggin County, Cumberland County, York County. Administration of the grant procedure shall be done by the existing staff of the Fire Service Training Program. Funds shall be provided on a 20% state, 80% county or local "in-kind" matching grant program. "In-kind" match shall include money, labor, materials, land and other items of establishable value. State share shall be in dollars.
