CHAPTER 127

H.P. 1276 - L.D. 1793

AN ACT to Create a Rape Crisis Center in Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
