## CHAPTER 51

H.P. 1168 - L.D. 1665

Resolve, Authorizing Kennebec County to Pay  
Deficits from Unappropriated Surplus.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the unforeseen jail personnel costs for Kennebec County forced Kennebec County to make additional expenditures in the jail budget; and

Whereas, the population of prisoners in Kennebec County has increased; and

Whereas, these expenses could not have been foreseen in the original Kennebec County budget but must now be met as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Kennebec County Commissioners; reimbursement for overdrafts authorized. Resolved: That the Kennebec County Commissioners are authorized to expend from the Kennebec County surplus account the sum of \$30,000 to meet overdrafts in the following jail department (1050) accounts:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Resolve shall take effect when approved.
